Since January 2, 2023, SAL members have been able to renew online via their individual myLegion account (https://mylegion.org) or SAL quick renewal link (https://legion.org/sal-renew). As of April 1^{st,} we have had 1900 members renew online. Squadrons and detachment can still conduct transmittals to renew members. Please ensure members are signing up for myLegion accounts with their email address that is on their membership record. If they sign up using a different email address, they will have to call National to have their login connected to their membership record.

There is only one "Full" dues rate for a Squadron member. Special rates such as Dual and junior payments are not available for online renewal and are to be processed at the squadron as it is today. If a member falling into a category of a special rate renews online, they will be charged full rate with no refund. Please ensure this information gets out to the members to avoid member services issues.

Dues for squadrons that have NOT submitted a Squadron Data Report (SDR) are now set to the national and detachment fee only. For example, national is \$5.00 and a detachment is \$5.00 the squadron fee is now \$10.00, and it will up to the squadron to acquire any additional fees.

To get the dues corrected, please submit a SDR to your detachment, department and national at postandsqdnupdates@legion.org.

This online renewal process will create money due to SAL Squadrons and is being paid to the departments for distribution to detachments. This is being handled in the same manner as Post refunds.
