To the Sons of The American Legion, Detachment of Texas:

I know that many of you have been wondering what is happening and I apologize for taking so long to get this update out. However, I wanted to avoid putting out conjecture and partial information if possible. That means that this update will be fairly lengthy. And regardless of efforts otherwise, some information may change as the situation warrants.

On a Detachment level, we are going to do what we can to follow and assist the direction of the Department of Texas. I will attach Commander Perkins most recent letter in total, in summary, it states:

• Department is open to trying to make time at the State Convention if any District or Division is not able to have their convention earlier. I am hoping we are not going to have to deal with this but if your Legion District or Division is not able to have their sessions prior, we will attempt to work with each situation individually. Our Detachment convention session is different from the Department's so we may have to make other arrangements, if necessary.

Boys State is being scheduled. Posts and Squadrons need to submit paperwork and funds for anyone they are sponsoring. Should Boys State end up getting canceled, refunds will be provided. Detachment Convention is still on the schedule.

I do want to emphasize that as of now Boys State is still on schedule. Posts and Squadrons need to follow through on registration paperwork and funding so that proper preparations can be made.

- The Junior Shooting Sports competition scheduled for July has been canceled.
- Boys Nation, also scheduled for July, has been canceled.
