MID-WINTER CONFERENCE AUSTIN, TX---JANUARY 22, 2022

SATURDAY, JANUARY 22, 2022

Reservations should be able to start in March. A complete report is attached to these minutes. Motion made by Chairman Elam, 2nd by Kevin Baker. Motion passed.

AWARDS—Chairman Fowler came forward to give the report. He stated that there are forms available for use on the website. All forms must be submitted prior to May \$1st. Brad Pack spoke to the body concerning PDC Ed Magers and the illness he has been through over the past period of time.
