SUBJECT: 2022 NATIONAL CONVENTION COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS

In accordance with the Uniform Code of Procedures for the Organization of National Conventions of the Sons of The American Legion, we have nine (9) established standing Convention Committees listed below:

1. AMERICANISM
2. CHILDREN & YOUTH
3. CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS
4. CREDENTIALS
5. INTERNAL AFFAIRS
6. MEMBERSHIP
7. FINANCE
8. LEGISLATION AND RULES
9. VETERAN'S AFFAIRS AND REHABILITATION

The convention rules state that the National Commander is to designate the members of these committees prior to the opening of the convention. The members of these committees are not restricted to delegates and alternate delegates. Any member attending the convention can serve on a committee, but they can serve on only one committee. The only restrictions are there be a minimum of five (5) members per committee, committees must be appointed in odd numbers, and no more than one member from any Detachment, however, any member is welcome to attend any meeting. The Convention Committees will meet on **Friday, August 26, 2022** beginning at **8:30 AM** at the **Miller High Life Theater in Milwaukee, Wisconsin**. The room assignments will be posted in the SAL staff office during registration times when the authorized representative picks-up their credentials.

NOTE: To facilitate the appointments and involve as many members as possible at the convention, National Commander, Michael Fox is requesting Detachments make committee appointment recommendations.
