National will not correct these numbers unless we cancel the non-active Squadrons which refuse to do. So, when calculating percentage, divide the turned in numbers by 153. That will give you a more real number. Also, before you submit your CSR to National, make sure I get a copy for the Detachment Awards. Thank you.

Subject: CPR/CSR Status report (4/21/26)

Greetings All,

Please find the details of this week's CPR/CSR Status reports attached and below. Be sure to catch important notes after the reporting figures.

The intent of this report is to provide departments and senior leadership with a snapshot of the CPR/CSR submission rates so that they may encourage posts/squadrons to submit their CPR/CSRs in a timely manner and continue to increase the Legion's overall reporting percentage. The information within these reports is absolutely vital for national congressional reports, as well as a variety of nationally presented awards.

The post/squadron **reporting period is June 1 through May 31.**
July 1 is the official deadline for department awards consideration to be presented at national convention. **THERE ARE ONLY 71 DAYS UNTIL JULY 1.**

For this year, posts/squadrons may continue to **submit late CPR/CSRs until September 4, 2026.**

Consolidated Post and Squadron Reports –

- 969 of the 11,737 CPRs are submitted with an 8.26% completion rate.
- 344 of the 5,809 CSRs are submitted with a 5.92% completion rate.
- *These figures are based off all currently active charters.*

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. *For awards purposes*, the following will be removed from the calculation:
 - a. **HQ/Admin posts/squadrons:** These do not have to submit CPR/CSRs but are encouraged to do so if any of the data fields are representative of efforts by HQ/admin posts/squadrons only.
 - b. **New posts/squadrons:** Those chartered during the current membership year (July 1 to June 30) who have not submitted a CPR/CSR will not count against the department's final submission rate
 - c. **Cancelled charters:** NEC-approved charter cancellations also will not count against the department's final submission rate, but these are automatically removed from the CPR/CSR status report anyway.

- d. **Blank CPR/CSR submissions:** These do not count for the purposes of awards and will also be removed from CPR/CSR reporting figures.
2. All submitted CPR/CSR data, regardless of post/squadron categorization and status, will remain in the system, and the data there will be included in all final CPR/CSR metrics for the purposes of NEC and congressional reports.
