### Benefits Policy Team (BPT) Operations

### **Meetings:**

- March 13: Policy team attended a VBA-VSO Quarterly meeting at PVA HQ to learn about VA Office of General Counsel (OGC) involvement on attorney contingency claims fees, how the Rudisill decision affects housing rates for those who qualified for both Mongomery & Post 9/11 GI Bills, and how rollover enrollment into VA Life affects those previously on Service-Disabled Veterans Life Insurance (S-DVI).
- March 14: Benefits & Claims Policy teams hosted Legion's Monthly DSO Leadership Check-in to disseminate crossflow of information regarding claims. Additionally, National Organization of Veterans' Advocates (NOVA) provided a Social Security Administration (SSA) SSDI Claims workshop for veterans nearing Total Disabled and Individual Unemployability (TDIU) and approaching retirement age who cannot quite make it due to their medical/disability conditions.
- March 17: Policy team virtually attended a DAV-VSO Biweekly Meeting to discuss the incoming Administration's VBA Workgroups/Synch meetings, and the need for VA to engage more and solicit feedback from VSOs on PACT Act implementation. The group also discussed pending legislation concerning unaccredited claims agencies.
- March 18: Policy team and Administrative Coordinator attended a Fall DSO Symposium planning session with Bergmann & Moore.
- March 19: Policy team made initial contact with the National Conference Center (NCC) to make prearrangements for a fruitful site visit.
